MISSION STATEMENT

To improve and strengthen California adoption policy and practice through a partnership of public and private agencies.

HISTORY

CAAA was established in 1954, in response to a need for standards regarding adoption practices. Working with the State on adoption regulations, CAAA helped ensure consistency and safeguards for children. As a result of this partnership, public adoption agencies were established and the stage was set for ongoing collaboration between public and private agencies.

CAAA's current goals include :

- Reviewing, creating and promoting legislation that supports children;
- Collaboration with the California State Department of Social Services to insure a dialogue and create a common voice and advocacy for children;
- Reviewing and revising standards and practice issues.

CAAA Member Agencies provide the following Services:

Special Needs Adoption

Adoption for children with medical, developmental, physical, and emotional disability, effects of abuse and neglect, or other considerations such as siblings who need to remain together.

Identified/Designated Adoption

Open Adoptions between adoptive parents and birth parents, supported by licensed agencies.

Confidential Adoptions

Adoption for birth parents or adoptive parents preferring to remain completely confidential at time of placement.

International Adoptions

Adoption for children born outside the United States and adopted by California families.

Post Adoption Services

Counseling, information and referral to supportive services for adoptees, birth parents and adoptive parents coping with lifelong issues of adoption.

Counseling and Education Services

Birth parent counseling to discuss available options. Workshops for adoptive parents to understand the impact of adoption.
